- Nagkaisa sa Kanilang pakay Efeso 3:11; Hebreo 9:14; Genesis 1:26.
- Nagtitipanan sa isa't isa Hebreo 13:20; 1:8-9; 9:14; 7:16-25; Efeso 1:3-23; 2Timoteo 1:8-10.
- Bilang sakdal na pamilya, komunidad o lipunan Mateo 28:19; Juan 17:24; 8:29; 3:34; 16:16-12-15.
- Nagkaisa sa Kanilang walang hanggang napagkasunduan kaayusan 1Corinto 14:40; 2Corinto 13:14; Juan 1:1; 1Juan 1:1-2; Juan 5:18, 19, 22, 23; Colosas 1:19; Hebreo 9:14.

>God the Son once and for all gave Himself to God the Father and voluntarily committed to do all that is pleasing to the Father (John 17:10, 8:29).



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THE BIBLICAL CONCEPT OF THE TRINITY AND THEIR WORKING RELATIONSHIP

The Trinity is the actual, infinitely perfect and essentially the same, in the eternally distinct but, mutually covenanting Persons of the three termed relationship of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Psalm 2:7; Isaiah 48:16; Matt. 3:16-17; Mark 1:9-11; Heb. 10:1-10; 9:14, etc.)

HOW THE GODKIND TRINITY WORKS

- From everlasting to everlasting the three Persons in the essentially one God which include the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are eternally living together and fellowshipping with one another (1Thess. 1:9; 1John 5:20; Heb. 9:14).
- Perfectly loving each other (1John 4:8; John 17:24; Gal. 5:22)
- United in their eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11; Heb. 9:14; Gen. 1:26);
- Mutually covenanting (Heb. 13:20; 1:8-9; 9:14; 2Tim. 1:8-10; etc.);
- As a perfect family, community or society (Matt. 28:19; John 17:24; 8:29; 3:34; 16:12-15);
- United in their agreed upon functions and positions (1Cor. 14:40; 2Cor. 13:14; John 1:1; 1John 1:1-2; John 5:18, 19, 22, 23; Col. 1:19; etc.);
- That all in all are from, on, in, through, with, to, and for the Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom 11:36; Gal 2:20; etc)
